Guy Riefler Associate Professor, Ohio University

Guy Riefler is an Associate Professor of Civil Engineering at Ohio University and a registered professional engineer in Ohio. He received environmental engineering degrees from Cornell University (BS) and the University of Connecticut (MS, PhD). Dr. Riefler's research focus is the remediation of pollutants in the environment and has worked on a variety of projects including the treatment of acid mine drainage, using iron nanoparticles to cleanup groundwater pollutants, the biodegradation and phytoremediation of explosives, vegetated biofilters for the treatment of stormwater, and growing algae for the production of biofuels. In his spare time he likes hiking, camping, and brewing beer.
